What is a School Budget?

- A school budget describes a district's plan for the upcoming year as related to anticipated revenues and expenditures.
- Schools operate on a fiscal year calendar beginning July 1 through June 30
- Requires input from parents, community, staff and stakeholders

How is a budget developed?

- Administration reviews current year expenses and projects the upcoming year's costs.
- Administration works with staff to project student enrollment, special education numbers and to analyze the current staffing to meet these needs.
- Administration and governing council member(s) receive information regarding projected unit value from NM Public Education Department.
- Parents, community and stakeholders make recommendations regarding program, instruction, and building needs.

How is a budget developed.. Cont'd

- All staff and the community were surveyed for their input.
- Administration and Ruby met weekly to discuss.
- The ILT, Equity Council and the Budget Committee are being asked to give additional input.
- Administration compiles the information from staff, public input and the NMPED and creates a preliminary budget.

Funding Sources

- The main sources are:
 - State Equalization Guarantee (SEG)
 - Federal Flow-through & Direct
 - Local Grants
 - State Flow-through & Direct
 - Lease Assistance
 - Capital Funding approved by the legislature
 - Budgeted surplus




- Worksheet to calculate SEG funding
 - Student enrollment (average 80/120)
 - Programs x cost index (multiplying factor) = program units
 - T & E / TCI Index
 - At-Risk Index
 - Unit value grand total units x Unit Value = program cost 2% (authorizer) = 98% SEG


Primary expense categories

- Other charges/fees


Staff Input












Community Input

Initiatives

- Using ESSER Funding
 - Additional interventionists
 - Counselor or Social Worker Full Time
 - Full Time English Language Development at the Middle School

Proposed Increases for 2023-2024

- Legislature HB2
 - Minimum salary for EA's \$25K
 - Increase of 6.0% for all staff
- Insurance
 - Medical benefits
 - 7.24% Increase High & Low Option & EPO Plans
- Risk Insurance
 - 2.3133% Increase Property/liability and WC
- NMERB
 - 1% Increase Employer portion



How a budget is approved

- The preliminary budget is presented to the governing council for final input
- The governing council votes to approve the budget
- After governing council approval, the budget is submitted to
 - Local authorizer
 - Copy to the NMPED for review

How a budget is approved.. Cont'd

- When the public education department approves, the budget becomes the district's Final Budget for the next school year
- The approved final budget is then entered into the district's financial system

Budget timeline

- Development process February April (June)
- GC approves budget April 24, 2023
- Budget due to APS for approval April 28,
 2023
- Budget due to PED for approval May 11, 2023
